## A CALL TO PRAYER

How fortunate we are to have heard the Good News! Jesus Christ is born. How terrible it is that so many young people don't know this. Many young people, as you may be aware, are not sure that Jesus was an historic person. So what did Christmas 2007 mean to the 12,000 or so students aged 11-18 who are being educated locally?

O.K. so ten Churches in Redhill and Reigate have united with each other and with many individuals like us to support Yvette [Upton] who takes this News to these students. Please continue to pray for Yvette, as well as for Jackie and Alan, who work so hard to teach about social issues; and for the other. Very good! Let's thank God for nine years' progress.

I don't like political 'targets', but Jesus did point to the immediacy of the situation; "the crop is heavy ... you must ASK the owner to send labourers to bring in the harvest". We should also remind ourselves of the local Primary schools where probably another 10,000 children are in Reception to Year 6. What does God want us to do for these? Should it be in time for next Christmas? Please join us as we ask Him for guidance. It may seem an impossible task! but then the LORD told Jeremiah "I am the LORD, is anything impossible for me?"

In 1903 two Christian ladies in Korea longed for revival and asked the LORD. The greatest revival was in 1907. The consequent Korean churches united and overcame 35 years of Japanese tyranny. Now there are 16,000 Korean missionaries in 170 countries.

Their and our example for praying is Jesus Christ who prayed alone after tiring days of ministry and in public, for example, when he looked to heaven and asked that there would be enough from a boy's lunch to feed the 4,000 – 10,000 by the lakeside. When his disciples wanted to know how to pray, he taught them to pray together saying "our Father in heaven ...". That was a new approach then, but is now part of our lives. Jesus also prayed before difficult decisions such as choosing 12 disciples and prior to the Cross at Calvary.

Perhaps we could at least start 2008 with persistent prayer; "if you call to me I will answer you" says God. We have less than a year before next Christmas to tell these young people Who it's all about.

As we take up this task may we each one continue to know God's peace and joy throughout this Term and the year ahead.
